The surface protected with PZP Ceramic Polish can be cleaned repeatedly without degrading the coating.

PZP Ceramic Polish is suitable for polished, nonabsorbent surfaces such as two-component paints, GRP, aluminium & Stainless Steel.

REMOVAL

PZP Ceramic Polish can be removed simply using mechanical buffing aids and the same polishing compounds used to prepare the paintwork prior to the application of PZP Ceramic Polish.

This means the PZP Ceramic Polish can be removed without sanding, extending the life of the paint ready for re-coat, making repairs simple.
